

Guidelines for Phase Two

1. Check the schedule and make sure which service you are scheduled to attend. If you plan to change, please let us know.
2. Please make it a point to arrive a few minutes early. The seating arrangements will be new and different and especially the first week or two it will be important to have some extra time to get settled.
3. When you first arrive, we ask that if you want to socialize and talk, please do this outside the church building, before or after the worship time.
4. When entering the building, we ask that you move directly to the auditorium to find your seat. We want to discourage mass gathering in the church lobby as this will function as a bottle neck and will make social distancing difficult.
5. Because of the latest mandate by the state of Ohio, we ask everyone to wear a mask in the building. Be respectful and give everyone six feet of clearance as a norm.
6. Seating: Every other row will not be used. We ask that when you sit down you maintain safe social distancing from non-family members. This will mean two empty chairs apart if you are sitting in the same row as a non-family member. We anticipate having a maximum of 70 people in a single service. This should allow for us to have plenty of social distancing.
7. Communion will be handled in a much different manner than we have in the past. Careful preparation procedures will be in place that will assure a “no touch communion” prior to everyone serving him/her self. We are confident that our method will be safe for all who participate. Trays will not be passed. Instead everyone will serve themselves from stations set up around the auditorium. Instructions will be given at communion time.
8. Offering trays will NOT be passed. Instead, two locked offering boxes will be set up for you to deposit your offering envelopes or money. You will need to take the initiative to find one of the offering boxes and place your offering in the slot provided.
9. No children’s programming or nursery will be offered during Phase Two. We will reinstitute appropriate children’s programming in the future.
10. We will not be serving coffee. Among other things, we want the flow of traffic through the lobby to keep moving (coming and going). You are welcome to bring your own coffee (in a cup with a lid). At some point in the near future we will be serving coffee again.
11. We will be filming and broadcasting the 10 AM service. If you attend that service you will notice the presence of the necessary equipment for that purpose. The service will be simulcast at 10 AM and automatically uploaded for anyone who wishes to view it. This will mean that it will not be available the day before like our Phase One messages have been. If

you are not able to attend our Phase Two services, the online messages will be available for you.

12. During the church service we ask that you NOT use the foyer as a place to hangout, gather, or socialize. We want to reserve the space in the foyer for parents with younger children dealing with childcare challenges. If you attend, please plan on being in the auditorium and joining in worship.
